Founded in 2018, we are a 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to providing educational opportunities to children in Guatemala. While living in Guatemala, our founder was introduced to and subsequently deeply moved by a children's home, Hogar Miguel Magone. Impacted by their will power and hurdles the children faced, she returned to the US to found Infinite Chance. Now, with a broad team (made up of US and Guatemalan based members), we are creating solutions and making impacts.

WHAT WE DO

We create sustainable, long-term programs for the children of Hogar Miguel Magone and the surrounding villages. We take advantage of existing infrastructure and systems in Guatemala, and supplement them with additional classes, activities, and experiences.

WHY SUPPORT US

We use funds to create opportunities that regenerate and compound, creating deeper impacts and lasting effects.



CURRENT

Our current projects include:

- English language program onsite
- Computer lab and courses onsite
- Preschool teacher and classroom onsite
- Assisting with uniform costs to attend local schools for 250+ students
- Providing high school tuition scholarships – we have 11 successful graduates who have moved on to post graduate studies
- Trade school scholarship program with a 100% graduation rate – 12 successful graduates

FUTURE

We believe in investing heaviest in **people** (teachers, mentors, support systems). Therefore, our future plans include:

- Building a job placement program and hiring a full-time job placement counselor for our graduates
- Creating a merit-based grant program for graduates for assistance with housing, transportation, and communication
- Researching and addressing factors that hinder adolescent development within Guatemala, regardless of education level
